### A hair lotion for the eradication of head lice and eggs.

You can use this product to treat your family without seeing a doctor, but use it carefully to get the best results.

**Read all this leaflet carefully before you start using this product.**

#### About head lice

Head lice vary in size according to their age. They may be between 1/2mm to 3mm long (from the size of a printed full stop up to the size of a sesame seed). Head lice can be difficult to spot because they can match their colour to that of the environment.

Live lice live close to the scalp where they feed on blood and this can cause the scalp to itch.

Head lice cannot jump, fly or swim and can only be acquired by direct head to head contact. This is why lice are commonly found on the heads of children and why it is important to check the heads of all the family members when head lice are found.

Head lice only live on humans and have no preference for clean or dirty hair.

The female louse will lay between 3 and 5 eggs per day and these hatch after 7 days. This is why it is important to repeat the process after 7 days to ensure that any lice which have hatched since the first application are killed.

Once the louse has hatched, the empty case (sometimes known as a nit) will remain glued to the hair shaft. Nits are completely harmless and can be removed with the fingers or a fine toothed comb. ### 1. What is Hedrin Treat & Go®, and what does it do?

Hedrin Treat & Go® Lotion is the easy, no-fuss way to get rid of head lice and their eggs. It's a light, non-sticky lotion which spreads quickly and easily on the hair. It has no nasty smells, is skin friendly and contains no known asthma triggers.

### 2. Before using Hedrin Treat & Go®

#### Do not use Hedrin Treat & Go®:

- If you are sensitive to any of the ingredients listed.

#### Take special care with Hedrin Treat & Go®:

- For external use only.
- Do not apply to broken skin.
- Avoid contact of the lotion with the eyes. If it accidentally comes into contact with your eyes, flush with water, if irritation persists seek medical advice.
- If using the spray format of Hedrin Treat & Go® do not spray on the face and avoid breathing the spray.

#### Use in pregnancy and breastfeeding

Hedrin Treat & Go® is unlikely to produce any ill effects if used during pregnancy and breastfeeding.



#### Use by children

Children under 6 months old should only be treated under medical supervision.

#### Driving and using machines:

Hedrin Treat & Go® does not affect your ability to drive or operate machinery.

### 3. How to use Hedrin Treat & Go®

Hedrin Treat & Go® is suitable for adults and children aged 6 months and over.

#### Please note:

If a member of the family has live head lice, check the other family members and treat all other cases of live head lice which are discovered, at the same time.

Hedrin® is for external use only.

Hedrin Treat & Go® has been formulated with non-volatile ingredients. However, normal safety precautions should be observed. Treated hair should always be kept away from naked flames.

#### Put it on

Apply straight onto dry hair, following the instructions on the pack. Shake the bottle well before use then rub or comb the lotion into the hair until it's covered from root to tip.

#### Leave it in

Let the hair dry naturally (or use a hairdryer if you prefer), then everyone's free to get on with their day. Leave it in at night if you like. Hedrin Treat and Go® needs to stay on for at least 8 hours.

#### Rinse out

Rinse or shampoo it out, you'll find it comes out really easily.

#### Do it again

After 7 days, repeat these simple steps again.

If you accidentally swallow some of the lotion you should consult a doctor as soon as possible. Take the pack with you to show which product you have swallowed.

### 4. Possible side effects

Most people who use Hedrin Treat & Go® will not experience side effects.

Known side effects are usually mild and normally occur briefly on first application –

- Tingling sensation or itching on the scalp.
- Sensation of cold or heat at the point of application.
- If accidentally introduced into the eyes, the eyes may become irritated.

**If any of these side effects get serious or you notice any other side effects not listed here, stop using the product and talk to a doctor or pharmacist.**

Do not continue to use Hedrin Treat & Go® if a skin rash or other signs of allergy occur. Wash the skin with mild soap and water and seek medical advice.

### 5. Storing Hedrin Treat & Go®

- Keep out of the reach and sight of children.
- Keep in the original carton.
- Store below 25°C in a cool place.
- Do not use after the expiry date shown on the pack.
- After use, the empty pack can be recycled.

### 6. Further information

#### What Hedrin Treat & Go® contains:

Hedrin Treat & Go® contains Octane- 1, 2-diol (Activdiol®).

Octane- 1,2-diol is not a chemical poison. It works by a physical process which effectively disrupts the outer skin of the louse and causes it to dehydrate and die.

The other ingredients are PEG-6 caprylic/ capric glycerides and water.

Hedrin Treat & Go® is available in lotion, spray and mousse formats.
